The Ron Taylor Award honors Professor Ronald L. Taylor, who served as Head of the Department of Sociology from 1981 to 1986. The award is made annually for the best paper by a graduate student in the Department of Sociology. In addition to the departmental recognition, the award includes a monetary prize. Papers for courses, for conference presentation, or for publication completed after January 2020 are eligible. In the case of co-authored papers, all authors must be graduate students in the department. Only one submission per student is permitted, with a maximum length of 12,000 words. Papers are to be submitted in Word format only and will not be accepted if they are submitted in PDF format.

Please submit an electronic copy of your paper to Kathy Covey. Your name should not appear on the paper. The award will be announced at the conclusion of the semester.
